**FALSIFICATION OF COVID 19 NUMBERS CONTINUES**

As I watch both alternative news sources and mainstream news shows, it is like watching two completely different worlds—one (that only a few people see) where independent reporters and analysts ask the right questions, challenge the official narrative and discover truthful answers; and the other world (that reaches the majority) where reporters constantly hype the fear of Covid 19, exaggerate the danger, and present a picture of compliance as if everyone is passively going along with this shutdown as dutiful “global citizens” because “we are all in this together.” Every mainstream news channel, both national and local, is parroting the same line, alternating between graphs showing the rising number of Covid 19 cases and deaths, and concerned citizens pledging to continue sacrificing until the government finally comes up with another “wonderful” vaccine to save them. Rarely do we hear about the millions who are starting to rebel at these unconstitutional restrictions on liberty. Never do we hear about the increasing evidence that the Covid 19 test captures a lot of other coronaviruses as well, yielding thousands of false positives. Worst of all, the mainstream media never tells us how thousands of death certificates are being falsely attributed to Covid 19, in order to hype the death rate. This week, I will present yet more evidence of all of these manipulations.

The [CDC instructions](#) for reporting deaths during this “pandemic” effectively encourage doctors and state health departments to list Covid-19 in the report even if they are not sure, and to test whenever possible:

*In cases where a definite diagnosis of COVID-19 cannot be made, but it is suspected or likely (e.g., the circumstances are compelling within a reasonable degree of certainty), it is acceptable to report COVID-19 on a death certificate as “probable” or “presumed.” In these instances, certifiers should use their best clinical judgement in determining if a COVID-19 infection was likely. However, please note that **testing for COVID-19 should be conducted whenever possible.***

There are two problems here: 1) It is violation of the time-honored practice of coroners and autopsy physicians to put anything on a death certificate other than that which is known by fact. They are not to presume or say “probable.” If they can't find a cause of death, they write, “cause unknown.” 2) Encouraging a Covid 19 test makes it appear as if the CDC is trying to be honest, but they are not. Testing will result in inflated numbers because, as I pointed out in last week's WAB, the CDC itself has admitted that the Covid 19 test picks up other coronaviruses, and is not a conclusive determinant of Covid 19 infection. And yet people are being denied their liberty based upon these inaccurate tests.

It appears that state and local health departments are echoing the CDC policy everywhere. A Minnesota state Senator and doctor, last name Jensen, was interviewed by a [TV host on KX4 Valley News](#) about a similar memo from he received from the Minnesota Health Agency, that

encouraged him as a doctor to label older persons dying of pneumonia or any flu-like symptoms as Covid 19, even in the absence of a positive test. He said he called the MN department of vital statistics to see if they agreed, and they said it is never appropriate to presume a cause of death. "Just put down the facts." But, the CDC and local health departments are pushing for listing even presumed links to Covid 19 on the death certificates.

Dr. Ann Bukacek, MD, an internal medicine specialist in Kalispell, Montana who has been practicing for 34 years, stated in this [excellent video](#), courtesy of Pastor Chuck Baldwin, that as of 4 April, and earlier the CDC is instructing all medical personnel to list the cause of death as Covid 19 even if Covid 19 is suspected of only being a contributing factor, they are instructed to list it as the cause of death. She also discusses how it is entirely improper to require doctors to put down "assumed causes of death" on a death certificate—something she has never seen before.

Someone or some group higher up in government wants this pandemic to look as bad as possible to justify all of the draconian shutdown measures enacted by most states. So far, **enforcement has been varying widely** from non-existent to very tyrannical depending on local authorities and police. On the extreme end there are threats of fines and even jail time for violating social distancing or face mask orders, and even for being on a beach now deemed closed to the public.

In one example, public health officials in Glenwood Springs, Colorado ordered citizens to wear face masks or [receive up to a year in jail!](#) Talk about assumed authority. No such penalties have ever been authorized by a legislature, and if they had been, they would not be

constitutional—although no one seems to be challenging any of this petty tyranny.

In Greenville, Mississippi police, on orders of the Mayor, raided a church drive-in service and issued \$500 tickets to the congregation in cars. The Pastor is [defying the order](#) and daring them to ticket them on Easter Sunday. WorldnetDaily.com covered a [myriad of Orwellian examples](#):

*Michelle Malkin wrote about the father in Brighton, Colorado, who was "handcuffed in an empty park by three police officers for playing T-ball with his 6-year-old daughter and wife." She said the restrictions have become "arbitrary, irrational and unevenly applied."*

*"While children's swings and slides are now crime scenes, golf courses and pickleball courts in my city are wide open," she wrote. "Weed and booze stores are considered 'essential.' Ice cream, dessert joints and fast-food outlets with takeout and delivery services are still operating. But family-owned, sit-down restaurants that have been staples in our community have been forced to shut their doors after decades in business."*

*ABC News reported the father, a former Colorado State Patrol trooper, Matt Mooney, was cuffed and held in a patrol car for a time. He said he walked with his wife and daughter from their home to a nearby park Sunday to play softball.*

*"We're just having a good time, not near anybody else. The next closest person is at least 15 feet away from me and my daughter at this point," he said.*

*Brighton police soon arrived to halt the activity. The police department later*

*apologized and said it was reviewing the incident.*

*MSN reported two New Jersey residents were arrested for allowing other people in their home for a wedding "in defiance of social distancing orders." They were reported by their neighbors.*

I am surprised that only 39 states have issued statewide "stay at home" orders with all the follow-the-leader weakness shown by governors, even Republicans. 11 states have issued statewide non mandatory advisories (Alabama, Missouri, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Utah and Wyoming) leaving it up to individual counties to issue lockdown orders (with no constitutional authority). Only Arkansas, Iowa, Nebraska, North Dakota and South Dakota have resisted completely the "stay at home" orders. Dr. "Sky is falling" Fauci expressed his displeasure that all states weren't in lock-step with each other, according to a [CNN interview](#):

*Dr. Anthony Fauci suggested Thursday night that all Americans should be under a stay-at-home order to mitigate the spread of the coronavirus, and that all states should be operating under the same guidelines.*

*"I don't understand why that's not happening," Fauci, a member of the White House coronavirus task force and director of the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases, said in an interview on CNN.*

Others do understand, and it is telling that Dr. Fauci can't seem to imagine why people do not want their lives shut down over "flattening some curve" for a disease that is not dangerous to healthy people. Incredibly, so-called "experts" are trying to prolong this shutdown despite the damage. They are trying to convince the

president that the [following criteria](#) must be met to get back to normal:

*Cases falling for 14 days, open hospital beds, a test for EVERY person showing symptoms and infection monitoring.*

Well, there are already open hospital beds all over the nation, a further testing will only boost the false positive numbers. Do they really want ankle monitors for infected people and enforced quarantine? Apparently so.

Fortunately, we have a president who is trying to get Americans back to work by May 1, but he is surrounded by people like Dr. Fauci who are determined to draw this out. Even FED Chairman Powell is warning Trump against a "[false start](#)" in May when it may take longer before the case numbers drop. That is what they want—to drag this out. But, I think resistance is building fast.

One Sheriff in Maine, is [refusing to following the governor's threat](#) of police action for violating her "stay at home" order:

*Maine's Franklin County Sheriff Scott Nichols has a strong message for the Governor of Maine, Janet Mills, who issued "stay-at-home" orders with threats of police punishment if not followed.*

*Sheriff Nichols issued a statement on the Franklin County Facebook page saying in no uncertain terms he will not follow the unconstitutional order. "We will not be setting up a Police State. PERIOD," he wrote.*

The first [major protest by demonstrators](#) demanding to get back to work, took place in Columbus Oh, outside the state capitol, demanding a return of our rights. But the medical tyrants entrenched in the federal government won't be moved until protests get

bigger, because of their allegiance to the globalist agenda.

Dr. Fauci has a long association with Bill Gates and his quest for mandatory vaccines for all the world, and that may explain his penchant for hype. I consider billionaire Bill Gates one of the most dangerous men in America, using his billions to foment every globalist's vaccine and control agenda. [Off-Guardian found an interview](#) where Gates reveals his goal for a vaccine mandated world:

*Right after that, at minute 34:14, Gates talked about how... “eventually what we’ll have to have is certificates of who’s a recovered person, who’s a vaccinated person... Because you don’t want people moving around the world where you’ll have some countries that won’t have it under control, sadly.*

*You don’t want to completely block off the ability for people to go there and come back and move around. So eventually there will be this digital immunity proof that will help facilitate the global reopening up.” [People like this who want to mandate travel controls deserve to live under Communism.]*

*[note:] Some time on the afternoon of March 31 the last sentence of **this quote was edited out** of the official TED video of the interview. Fortunately, recordings of the complete interview are archived elsewhere.*

*In the October 2019 Event 201 novel-corona virus-pandemic simulation co-sponsored by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation, the World Economic Forum and a division of the Johns Hopkins Bloomberg School of Public Health, a poll that was part of the simulation said that 65% of people in the U.S. would be*

*eager to take a vaccine for COVID-19, “even if it’s experimental.”*

Disturbing as it is to consider how many in this world still believe in vaccine safety and trust the vaccine industry, it also shows that a growing percentage do not. As [Big League Politics pointed out](#), Dr. Fauci has an ongoing relationship with this vaccine cult.

*Dr. Anthony Fauci, who has become a beloved doom prophet fomenting mass hysteria among the American public amidst the coronavirus pandemic, once worked with technocratic oligarch Bill Gates on his “Global Vaccine Action Plan.”*

*Activist reporter Mike Coudrey drew attention to this fact on his Twitter account in a post from Sunday: “Dr. Fauci served a leadership role on the Global Vaccine Plan through partnership with the Bill and Melinda Gates foundation. Naturally, he’ll push back against the Hydroxychloroquine + Azithromycin treatment and instead opt for a patented vaccine.”*

*The “Global Vaccine Action Plan” was announced in 2010 as a public-private partnership of the World Health Organization (WHO), the United Nations Children’s Fund (UNICEF), the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases (NIAID), and the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation.*

*As the NIAID director, Fauci helped guide the vaccine-pushing project as a member of its Leadership Team. He was joined by other globalist kingpins including Anthony Lake, Executive Director for UNICEF; Margaret Chan, Director General of WHO; Joy Phumaphi, Chair of the International Advisory Committee and Executive Secretary,*

*African Leaders Malaria Alliance; and Tachi Yamada, President of Global Health at the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation [all are either globalists or China lackeys].*

*Fauci has been the primary voice in the Trump administration urging the public to be skeptical of hydroxychloroquine... When it became clear that hydroxychloroquine can be effective in treating the coronavirus, Fauci walked back his comments.*

*Fauci may be trying to halt the use of hydroxychloroquine as part of the “Global Vaccine Action Plan” that he plotted many years ago. Gates has already talked about digital tracking implants being tagged into people’s skin for authorities to enforce their vaccination schedule. Fauci could be serving as a bureaucratic enabler of Gates’ sociopathic Big Brother ambitions.*

While it may well be true that Fauci and others are fighting the use of *hydroxychloroquine* to make sure people demand and take a more dangerous vaccine, I think people in opposition to this lockdown hysteria need to get over looking to Big Pharma for a drug solution. Just take a look at the side-effects of hydroxychloroquine, and you will think twice about taking this either. Why take a drug, which puts you in the hands of an establishment doctor (with the power to put you in quarantine), in order to get a prescription for a drug, when natural supplements and vitamins easily do the job? If there is anything everyone needs to learn from this overblown pandemic, it is stay away from the establishment medical system!

Here s a real life example of a professional person who came down with Covid 19 and almost died because he started taking over-the-counter anti-inflammatory pills (Ibuprofen, Tylenol). He was only saved because a colleague

at work put him in contact with a Dr. Ing, who follows Dr. David Brownstein’s natural protocols. He was better within 3 days. Here is [Dr. Brownstein’s video interview](#) with the patient.

He mentions being cured with large doses of Vit. C, and regular additions of vitamins D3 and A. But you should always include Zinc and some form of nascent iodine and colloidal or nano-silver.

Beware: in order for natural remedies to be effective, you have to be **eating right** (no junk food, sweets or diet drinks, etc) with mostly organic, non-factory prepared foods, in moderate quantities. In this patient’s case, the natural cure worked anyway, so they are effective in high doses, even when a person lacks optimal health. But, don’t count on it. Eating right will improve your chances dramatically. I also suspect this patient was immune-deficient in order to have gotten such a bad case in the first place. The fact that he rushed to take Tylenol etc. indicates he is used to getting sick with colds and flu. Some [experts are saying](#) that,

*Having just ONE underlying health condition raises your risk of being admitted to intensive care or dying with coronavirus by almost 80%*

[USA Today [reported that](#),] *The majority of New York’s more than 4,700 deaths due to coronavirus were among men, and 86% of all deaths were among people who had underlying illnesses, such as hypertension and diabetes, new state data shows. In addition, 63% of the deaths were among those age 70 and older, while 7% of the cases were those 49 and younger.*

In reality, if you count damage to the immune system through use of pharmaceutical drugs and

vaccines, all those who died had some other underlying cause or a damaged immune system. And if you are chronically overweight and have low basal body temperature (below 97.5 deg) you are also thyroid deficient, and in declining health—even if you don't realize it. And, most people that are thyroid deficient are also adrenal deficient, which overworks to compensate for low thyroid output.

At least 60% of Americans are thyroid deficient (because of hereditary aspects of long depleted iodine levels in US soil, especially in the South) and almost 90% of older people are thyroid deficient. This is one of the reasons why most older people are overweight, and have chronic disease. In fact, according to the top expert on thyroid I know, **almost no one with a healthy thyroid gets heart disease or cancer; making it the “great protector” of good health**, for those who eat right. This is probably the best overall health tip I can give you, long-term.

The thyroid gland regulates almost all other body functions, so if you find yourself unresponsive to or intolerant of natural remedies and very susceptible to disease, check your underarm temperature while resting in bed in the morning for low body temp. If you are below 97.5 you are hypothyroid and need to take supplemental NATURAL thyroid hormone (not Synthroid). Sadly it is by prescription only and most doctors won't prescribe without a TSH blood test, which is notoriously incapable of detecting common hypothyroidism. Only the basal temperature test works consistently. You may also need to supplement with small doses of hydrocortisone to make up for adrenal depletion. Some naturopaths know about this issue and can help.

### **Dire Death Projections Continue to be Proven Wrong**

So far this entire scare-mongering pandemic has been based on skewed or insufficient data, or

worse yet, obscene projections of 200K or more deaths in the US. As time marches on, it is becoming obvious that the wild-eyed, fear-inducing projections have been very wrong. This week, Dr. Robert Redfield, the Director of the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), admitted that the death toll from the Chinese coronavirus will be “much, much, [much lower](#)” than the models projected. Of course, instead of admitting that their numbers were over-hyped to begin with, they claim the low numbers are due to “Americans following social distancing recommendations,” as I predicted. This way they can reinforce the need to use this arbitrary government power again and again in the future. We will continue to see this this excuse in weeks and months to come as the fearmongers try and explain away their false projections, rather than admit to criminal fraud and distortion. Market-Ticker [came to a similar conclusion](#):

*This whole thing reeks of the so-called "Precautionary Principle". If the possibility of something terrible exists, then we MUST do whatever it takes to prevent said possibility. They do the same with Global Warming. No measure, no proposal is too extreme!*

*Two generations now have been raised on this way of thinking, and a third is getting their baptism into the cult before our very eyes...The [Covid 19] model is worthless. Fauci should be sued for hyping this and causing all this economic damage.*

*The lower boundary for claimed need for hospital beds is 120,000 as of yesterday. The actual number required was just under 41,000, a miss of more than 300% to the high side.*

*The lower boundary for ICU beds needed as 21,383, a miss to the high side of more than 200%.*

*The lower boundary for ventilators required was 17,066, a miss to the high side of more than 1,300%. I repeat -- THIRTEEN TIMES.*

*These projections were updated four days earlier and account for "full social distancing" by force of government -- that is, guns in the face, which many states have not employed. Not one of the projections at the lower end of the confidence band has proved up.*

*Every single one has been off by at least a factor of 2 on the low end of the confidence band. If you look at the center of the range it's even worse, and the high side is flat-out comical with the miss being as much as 25 TIMES.*

Rather than admit error (which would make them liable for all the economic damage to the nation) the purveyors of doom, will keep claiming that lower numbers are because "we locked down more than the model predicted." Although president Trump bought into a large part of this mess, at least he did NOT mandate a total lock down as they demanded. All too many states did.

The real truth is that heavily infected cities and states, all in Democrat-controlled urban areas, have both high densities of crowding and pollution, and thus, a higher percentage of unhealthier people who are more susceptible to the flu each year, as well as Covid 19. All these factors correlate with urban city life. Only those people who take great care to eat right and exercise hard beat the odds.

Despite all that, the **overall numbers of deaths are not much higher this year, if at all, than**

**last year with the flu** —which also kills thousands of obese, diabetic, pneumonia-prone older people. Ryan McMaken via The Mises Institute presented this evidence on the [normal death rates](#) and how they should compare with Covid 19 deaths if properly assigned.

*About 2.9 million people die in the United States each year from all causes. Monthly this total ranges from around 220,000 in the summertime to more than 280,000 in winter.*

*In recent decades, flu season has often peaked sometime from January to March, and this is a major driver in total deaths. The average daily number of deaths from December through March is over eight thousand.*

*... according to some sources, it is not clear that total deaths have increased significantly as a result of COVID-19. In a March 30 article for The Spectator, former UK National Health Service pathologist John Lee noted that the current number of deaths from COVID-19 does not indicate that the UK is experiencing "excess deaths."*

*How do these numbers look in the United States? During March of 2020, there were 4,053 COVID-19 deaths according to Worldometer. That is 1.6 percent of total deaths in March 2019 (total data on March 2020 deaths is still too preliminary to offer a comparison). For context, we could note that total deaths increased by about four thousand from March 2018 to March 2019. So for March, the increase in total deaths is about equal to what we already saw as a pre-COVID increase from March 2018 to March 2019.*

*As Lee notes, total COVID-19 deaths could still increase significantly this season, but*

*even then we must ask what percentage of total deaths warrants an international panic. Is it 5 percent? Ten percent? The question has never been addressed, and so far, a figure of 1 percent of total deaths in some places is being treated as a reason to forcibly shut down the global economy.*

Keep in mind that some or many of the deaths attributed to Covid 19 are assumed and/or overstated because even testing is not capable of distinguishing between Covid 19 and other corona viruses.

*Yet, as a CDC report recently noted, pneumonia deaths have often been far more common than COVID-19 deaths are right now: "Based on National Center for Health Statistics (NCHS) mortality surveillance data available on March 26, 2020, 8.2 percent of the deaths occurring during the week ending on March 21, 2020 (week 12), were due to [pneumonia and influenza]."*

*In the current climate, anyone with a positive test for Covid-19 will certainly be known to clinical staff looking after them: if any of these patients dies, staff will have to record the Covid-19 designation on the death certificate—contrary to usual practice for most infections of this kind. There is a big difference between Covid-19 causing death, and Covid-19 being found in someone who died of other causes. Making Covid-19 notifiable might give the appearance of it causing increasing numbers of deaths, whether this is true or not. It might appear far more of a killer than flu, simply because of the way deaths are recorded.*

*This is extremely likely to inflate the number of deaths attributed to COVID-19 while pulling down deaths attributed to other influenza-like illnesses and to deaths caused*

*by pneumonia with unspecified origins. This is especially problematic since we know the overwhelming majority of COVID-19 deaths occur in patients that are already suffering from a number of other conditions. In Italy, for example, data shows 99 percent of COVID-19 deaths occurred in patients who had at least one other condition. More than 48 percent had three other conditions. Similar cases in the US are now likely to be routinely reported simply as COVID-19 cases.*

*We do know historically, however, that deaths attributed to flu and pneumonia over the past decade have tended to make up around five to ten percent of all deaths, depending on the severity of the "season." Last week (week 14, the week ending April 4) was the first week during which COVID-19 deaths exceeded flu and pneumonia deaths, coming in at 11 percent of all death for that week. The prior week, (week 13, the week ending Mar 28) COVID-19 deaths made up 3.3 percent of all deaths.*

*Until we have reliable numbers on all deaths in coming weeks, it will be impossible to know the extent to which COVID-19 are "cannibalizing" flu and pneumonia deaths overall. That is, if the COVID-19 totals skyrocket, but total deaths remain relatively stable, than we might guess that many deaths formerly attributed simply to pneumonia, or to flu, are now being labeled as COVID-19 deaths.*

The last point McMaken talks about is crucial. If the media claims that Covid 19 deaths are skyrocketing or extremely high, but the total number of deaths compared to last year is about the same, then we will know the high Covid 19 numbers are simply because of **false assignment of Covid 19 as the cause of death**. Watch for it.

It is going to become even more clear as we go, and it will give us the proof we need that this was an overblown crisis. But you will never see any of this analysis by the controlled media. USA Today [reported that](#),

*The majority of New York's more than 4,700 deaths due to coronavirus were among men, and 86% of all deaths were among people who had underlying illnesses, such as hypertension and diabetes, new state data shows. In addition, 63% of the deaths were among those age 70 and older, while 7% of the cases were those 49 and younger.*

### **More Evidence the Covid 19 Tests are Flawed**

Last week I presented evidence and this week there is more: [Julian Rose of Global Research](#) quotes an expert that says quick Covid 19 tests are testing people for any strain of coronavirus, not specifically for Covid 19:

*I work in the healthcare field. Here's the problem, we are testing people for any strain of a Coronavirus. Not specifically for COVID-19. There are no reliable tests for a specific COVID-19 virus. There are no reliable agencies or media outlets for reporting numbers of actual COVID-19 virus cases. This needs to be addressed first and foremost. Every action and reaction to COVID-19 is based on totally flawed data and we simply can not make accurate assessments.*

*The 'gold standard' in testing for COVID-19 is laboratory isolated/purified coronavirus particles free from any contaminants and particles that look like viruses but are not, that have been proven to be the cause of the syndrome known as COVID-19 and obtained by using proper viral isolation methods and controls (not the PCR that is currently being used or Serology /antibody tests which do not*

*detect virus as such). PCR basically takes a sample of your cells and amplifies any DNA to look for 'viral sequences', i.e. bits of non-human DNA that seem to match parts of a known viral genome.*

*The problem is the test is known not to work. It uses 'amplification' which means taking a very very tiny amount of DNA and growing it exponentially until it can be analyzed. Obviously any minute contaminations in the sample will also be amplified leading to potentially gross errors of discovery.*

*Additionally, it's only looking for partial viral sequences, not whole genomes, so identifying a single pathogen is next to impossible even if you ignore the other issues.*

One expert came to an ominous conclusion about the difficulty of doing a quick test for Covid 19—the number of false positives ensures you can easily create a crisis: “If you want to pick a virus to create a pandemic, pick a corona virus which are incredibly common.” That is what they have done.

### **Some Bizarre Conspiracy Claims**

I believe in credible conspiracies, of which there are many. But some claims are false or partially false and need to be countered. Here are a few of the latest:

1) Those that deal with highly speculative things like UFOs, aliens, and lizard people. I have covered in prior briefs that UFO's are real and not something that could be controlled by people on earth. Our earth is restricted to the laws of physics during its mortal existence as a testing place, and although I think some alien technology violates these rules of physics, I don't believe we can absorb their technology and also violate the rules of this testing period.

2) The latest from the Q community is that the Covid 19 crisis is a cover for “mass pedophile arrests.” There is no truth to any of Q’s claims about Trump taking down the Deep State, Pedophiles or otherwise. It won’t happen, and Trump does not have a clue how to do it.

3) Is Covid-19 a Chinese bioweapon released by accident? Yes, but it wasn’t fully developed yet. It is not deadly enough to healthy people to be useful as a bioweapon. Was the Gates’ Foundation behind the lab in Wuhan? No. Helping the Chinese is part of the globalist agenda, and the Chinese will take money from globalists but don’t trust them inside their weapons labs.

4) Mike Adams’ condemnation of David Ickes and others who claim this virus is overblown. Adams claims it is going to be worse than the establishment claims. He is also hying that this will lead to WWII with china, and I completely disagree. Adams has always been prone to hype, even on true conspiracies, but he is way over the top in these claims.

I will summarize about the evil of these mandated shutdowns with an excerpt from an [editorial by Montana State Rep. John Fuller](#), R-Kalispell.

*Being told that 1 million Montanans are under “house arrest” and that every “non-essential” business must close its door is an irrational response to save the lives of a few. The logic displayed during this current “pandemic” would necessitate that **nothing ever be allowed that would put more than 1 percent of a given population at risk...***

*We did not vote on the “shelter-in-place” dictum. We did not vote on the shut down of all “non-essential” businesses. Hysteria*

*leads to a dismissal of the factual... Does anyone really expect now that a governor has assumed the power to decide who is essential or not, that future governors will not expand on such policies? Increasing dependence on government and passively accepting that some “elite” somewhere knows best about our welfare is much more dangerous than the Wuhan virus. The natural desire to be “safe” often suppresses the need to be free. But abandoning one’s own responsibility to provide for their own safety will result in government tyranny. And you will still die.*

## **TRUMP’S SPAT WITH THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION**

President Trump has seen enough of the coverage on Fox News to learn that the World Health Organization (WHO) has been covering for China’s accidental release of the virus from their weapons lab, as well as China’s many false claims early on about the virus not being contagious or dangerous, and downplaying the epidemic in Wuhan. On Tuesday Trump came out with [strong criticism of the WHO](#):

*Tuesday, Trump criticized the WHO as slow to respond to the crisis, and repeatedly said the organization has been “China-centric.” He complained that the WHO “receives vast amounts of money from the United States” and that the organization “called it wrong.”*

*“They could have called it months earlier,” he said. “They would have known and they should have known and they probably did not. So we’ll be looking into that very carefully.”*

Trump is right. The reason the WHO is so China-centric is partly because China lobbied to have one of their African puppets, Dr. Tedros, be put in as the head of the WHO, as the [Daily Mail reported](#). They explain how China lobbied to put

this non-doctor in as head of this global “health” organization. This should come as no surprise. A great many UN agencies are run by communists.

*Tedros Ghebreyesus is Director-General of the WHO and [is] leading [the] global response to [the] coronavirus pandemic. He studied in the UK before serving at the top of Ethiopia's government and was part of hard-left TPLF party (pro-communist). During that time, contributions by China to Ethiopia via various UN programmes increased dramatically.*

*In 2017 he was elected to lead the WHO, amid allegations of heavy lobbying by Chinese diplomats. His response to the pandemic has been heavily criticised, particularly his praise for China's government... and refusing to criticize China's suppression of the outbreak and arresting Chinese doctors blowing the whistle on the communist government.*

*Dr Tedros - who has never practised as a medical doctor - is a career politician who was born in what is now Eritrea, studied in the UK, then rose to the top of Ethiopia's government first as Health Minister and then Foreign Minister before being elected to lead the WHO in 2017.*

The Epoch Times (an anti-Communist News source by Chinese-American dissidents) produced a [comprehensive documentary](#) on the Chinese origins of the virus, the operation of the Wuhan BIO4 weapons lab and the evils of the Communist Party in prohibiting any release of information or cooperation with international organizations. It is hard-hitting about the real situation in China.

Trump has vowed to cut off funding for the WHO, and Sen. Lindsey Graham, chairman of

the powerful Senate Appropriation Committee Subcommittee on State, Foreign Operations, and Related Programs vowed [no funding for the WHO](#) in the next appropriations bill.

### **FED BACKSTOPPED BY TREASURY SO IT “DOESN’T LOSE ANY MONEY”**

Something unique happened this week, that has conservatives crying foul—that the FED and the US Treasury have finally merged. Well, I have news for you. They have always been in bed together. What has come out this week just makes it more visible, and explains why the FED has always refused to be audited. Pam Martens and Russ Martens of [Wall Street on Parade](#) [explain](#):

*On Thursday, March 26, in the midst of a growing panic on Wall Street over a lack of liquidity for toxic debt, the Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell did something unprecedented. He appeared live on the Today show. His interviewer, Savannah Guthrie, opened the interview by noting that one writer had said that the Fed can simply conjure money out of thin air. (It can.) Guthrie asked Powell if there was any limit to the amount of money the Fed was willing to put into the economy to keep it afloat. Her question should have been: is there any limit to the amount of money the Fed will conjure out of thin air to keep Wall Street afloat?*

*Powell said this: “In certain circumstances like the present, we do have the ability to essentially use our emergency lending authorities and the only limit on that will be how much backstop we get from the Treasury Department. We’re required to get full security for our loans so that we don’t lose money. So the Treasury puts up money as we estimate what the losses might be...Effectively \$1 of loss absorption of*

*backstop from Treasury is enough to support \$10 of loans.”*

*Powell was forced to do damage control on Thursday because White House Economic Advisor Larry Kudlow had let the cat out of the bag at a press briefing the Tuesday evening prior that Main Street would be getting less than \$2 trillion from the stimulus bill while the Fed would be getting \$4 trillion as a result of its ability to leverage its share of the stimulus money, making this actually a \$6 trillion stimulus bill. When the final stimulus bill was signed, the Fed got \$454 billion of taxpayer money to cover its losses, which it can thus leverage up to \$4.54 trillion to buy up the toxic debt that is exploding all over Wall Street.*

*Powell made it sound like the U.S. Treasury putting up taxpayer money at the Fed to absorb losses on Wall Street’s bad bets is the most normal thing in the world and a long-established practice.*

It is true, and has been going on for a long time, secretly. The Martens in the above link go on to give examples. And, as we expected, the bailouts aren’t through. Nancy Pelosi is trying to get another multi-billion dollar bailout passed, and trying to insert vote-by-mail into the deal—another boon to allow illegals to vote, who are all getting driver’s licenses (the basis for sending out ballots). Trump rightly opposes this latest vote-getting ploy.

And not surprisingly, [US airlines want a \\$50 billion bailout](#). They are short of cash like a lot of corporations who have been spending cash buying back their own stock. Airlines in the past 5 years spent \$45 billion buying back stock.

## **IDAHO GOVERNOR SIGNS ANTI-TRANSGENDER BILLS**

This is a big story because a very effective lobbying campaign by conservatives were able to put enough “fear of God” into a liberal Republican Idaho Governor that he felt constrained to sign the bills after all the major LGBT groups and national media pressured him for a veto. Hardly any Republican governors have the courage to stand up for reason in the face of the gay onslaught pushing false transgender rights. Mass Resistance, the most effective anti-gay lobby in the nation did the lion’s share of the work and [posted this](#):

*This week Idaho became the first state in the country to enact specific laws to protect the public from the aggressive “transgender” agenda. On Monday, March 30, Gov. Brad Little signed the two prominent bills that had been passed overwhelmingly by the GOP-dominated Legislature.*

*But it was a big fight. As we reported last week, there was a massive nationwide campaign to persuade the Governor to veto them. MassResistance worked hard to counter the negative campaign by mobilizing people in Idaho and across the country to exhort the Governor to sign the bills, using forceful arguments.*

*Here are the two bills that are now enacted into law:*

**HB 500** *says that only females (not males pretending to be females) may compete in girls’ or women’s school and college sports.*

**HB 509** *requires that public documents – such as birth certificates and drivers’ licenses – use a person’s biological sex, rather than the person’s contrived “gender identity.”*

*These would appear to be simply common sense – but they infuriated the national LGBT movement.*

*While the bills were making their way through the Idaho Legislature, over three dozen national corporations attempted to intimidate the legislators with “threats” against the state if these bills passed. After the bills got to the Governor’s desk, the campaign intensified.*

*Even though the two bills easily passed in Idaho’s conservative Legislature, many pro-family activists feared the worst when they got to the Governor’s desk. Republican Gov. Brad Little had a less-than-stellar pro-family record during his years in Idaho politics. As one activist told us:*

*“I know Gov. Little personally. He is pro-abortion. Fourteen years ago he was the deciding vote in the state Senate blocking putting Idaho’s Marriage Protection Amendment on the ballot until he was hammered by radio ads calling him out. He was the most ‘moderate’ of the three GOP primary candidates for Governor in 2018 and won only because two more conservative candidates split the conservative vote.”*

*During a Feb. 19 press conference, the Governor was asked about the bills. He answered “I don’t think we ought to be sending signals that we’re intolerant in Idaho,” Little said. “That’s my personal position.”*

*The national LGBT organization “Human Rights Campaign” (HRC), which also funds homosexual and transgender programs in the nation’s elementary schools, appears to have been the ringleader of the campaign, with the LGBT group GLSEN also running a national grassroots effort. (HRC has also teamed with the National Education Association, ACLU, and Gender Spectrum to promote*

*transgender programs for students in grades K-12.)*

*The mainstream media, such as CNN, CBS News, and the Idaho Statesman newspaper, basically parroted the LGBT propaganda.*

*That tactic of bringing together major corporations and other prominent organizations to pressure the politicians has been extremely successful across the country. Luckily, we didn’t let the Idaho Legislature and Governor succumb to it.*

Of course, one of the biggest ways to get a governor to succumb is for the ACLU and others to threaten the state with an expensive discrimination lawsuit.

*Three major pro-family law firms—the Pacific Justice Institute, Liberty Counsel, and the Alliance Defending Freedom—informed the Legislature and Governor that they were prepared to help defend the two laws once enacted. This would save the state a huge amount of money.*

*The citizens of Idaho were not afraid to speak bluntly and expose the insanity of males “identifying” as females (and vice-versa) while forcing others to comply with their delusion. To use psychiatrist Paul McHugh’s phrase, the citizens refused to “collaborate with and promote a mental disorder.”*

The national mainstream media was furious with its defeat in Idaho. Forbes’ headline read: “Idaho Governor Signs The Nation’s Most Anti-Transgender Measures Into Law”

*We can’t remember the last time the national media reacted so angrily to some fairly minor legislation in the Idaho Legislature. It’s a testament to the power that the LGBT movement has over them. It also shows the*

*extent of their incredible bias – truly “fake news.”*

## **NEWS SHORTS**

### **Donald Trump Fires Acting Navy Secretary:**

Acting Navy Secretary Thomas Modly flew all the way out to Guam in order to [relieve the Captain of the carrier USS Roosevelt](#) of his command, after his plea to the Navy Department to allow his infected crew members to get off the ship in Guam was leaked to the press. The Navy had denied his request initially, and the Navy brass suspected he had leaked his denied request to the media in order to get action.

Acting Secretary Modly took the opportunity to criticize the Captain for being “naive or stupid” for thinking his communication wouldn’t leak out and took the next 45 minutes to lecture the crew about how he had to relieve the captain of his command—a career ending proposition in the Navy. The crew reacted with booing and jeers. They considered Captain Brett Crozier a hero for standing up for his crew’s welfare before the Navy brass. When Modly’s self-serving address finally ended and Captain Crozier descended the walkway, the crew spontaneously erupted in cheers.

When Modly got back to Washington, he was brought before an outraged President Trump and summarily fired. Technically, he was “allowed to resign” so as to save face, but everyone in the Navy knows it was because of his self serving speech, grandstanding and demeaning of a well-respected officer. I don’t know what will happen to Crozier but he should get his command reinstated. That probably won’t happen as the military brass never likes to admit error.

**Media Criticizes Trump for Firing Inspector General at the State Dept.** The mainstream media had only negative coverage of Trump’s firing of Michael Atkinson as IG for the State

Dept. Atkinson took up the false cause of the CIA mole in the Trump administration that started the whole Ukraine impeachment scandal—sounding the alarm to Congress last September. Now, the media are crying foul that the Intel community is without an Inspector General.

But they conveniently forget about their total silence during Hillary Clinton’s term as Secretary of State when she refused to fill the Inspector General vacancy at State—to make sure no one would be watching over her illegal activities there (including the email scandal).

### **EU Trying to Float their Own Bailout Scheme:**

Using the coronavirus scare as justification and following somewhat the example of the US FED, the EU is trying to talk member states into authorizing the EU into floating a huge issue of Eurobonds. They don’t have the same monetary power of the FED to simply inflate the Euro as the FED does to create dollars, so they are turning to bonds. This is actually a key next step in power that the EU has always wanted to do in becoming a global government—claiming the power to create debt on the backs of EU citizens, but the financial sector of Germany, the Netherlands and others are balking hard. As one of my British contacts wrote,

*The German Constitutional Court as implied that Eurobonds would be ruled illegal by that court if the German Government were ever to sign up to them in future and were to be challenged... However... since that 2012 ruling some German academic lawyers (pro-EU)— in the minority, have continued to argue that Eurobonds would somehow be consistent with the Federal Basic Law.*

*Since the sudden flurry of talk about Eurobonds began last month, the tenor of the*

*German business press has been that they are unconstitutional as far as Germany is concerned... Article 125 of the Lisbon Treaty prohibits [the issuance of] government bonds by the EU; no change to that no-bailouts clause is expected for the foreseeable future. Consequently, the German Constitutional Court would ban common European Coronavirus bonds. As the German Government is very well aware of this, it will never acquiesce to [Eurobonds] in Brussels.*

*In the Netherlands, the conservative half of Parliament is determined to resist the introduction of Eurobonds with what seems like a comfortable majority if it is ever put to a vote, and the political chatter here is much as it is in the German quality press: that Berlin would never sign up to Eurobonds either.*

*[Trouble is,] The ECJ of course resolutely insists that it alone is competent to adjudicate the meaning of EU treaty texts in the event of such a dispute between member states or between Brussels and a member state, but the German Constitutional Court has a tradition of insisting that it has the final say in such matters for Germany.*

It will be interesting to see which way this goes. But it is good to see that the EU banks don't have the capability of unlimited money creation as does the FED.

**PREPAREDNESS TIP: 5 MULTI-USE ITEMS TO STOCKPILE** by Andrew Skousen  
Sometimes the most useful household products get overlooked in our preparations because we always seem to have them on-hand, or they seem to be available everywhere. Here are 5 [more items](#) that aren't purchased frequently, but have a wide variety of uses. All of these items store forever, so they are easy to stockpile, and make

for valuable barter someday. Don't be caught without them in hard times.

**Freezer bags:** Heavy duty sealable plastic bags such as the Ziploc brand are useful even if your freezer goes out. They hold a variety of items or liquids, are transparent and can be used both to keep moisture in (to avoid freezer burn) and keep moisture out (such as dried food or matches, etc.). Even a modestly-sized backup solar power setup will keep a freezer going, and it will be well worth the power it consumes. Any freezer activity will need a lot of freezer bags to enclose items in a sealed package that minimizes freezer-burn. The gallon and quart size Ziploc freezer bags are the most useful, but I would also stock up on the thinner sandwich size bags and on two-gallon (or larger) sealable bags from other brands. There are other ways of freezing things that you should be aware of, including plastic and glass containers (if you are careful to keep them from breaking when liquids expand) and "[freezer paper](#)" (plastic impregnated butcher paper).

**Permanent Markers:** A key part of organization and managing your flow of goods is labeling. Whether recording processing or purchase dates on each item being added to your stockpiles or recording contents on opaque packages, marking ownership of tools and hard goods, and many other uses, everyone should have multiple packs of permanent markers. Black is the most important, but other colors are handy too. Brands include [Sanford Sharpie](#), [Avery Marks-A-Lot](#), and colorful [Bic Pens](#). There are also [generic brands](#).

**Coffee Filters:** The finely woven mesh of coffee filters is made of virgin wood fibers so it is safe to use around food. It is also manufactured with a tight weave, so it won't let stray strands flake off when wet. This makes it useful for a variety of projects dealing with food and separating

particles from liquids. We have used them to drain whey from yogurt, herbal tea from herbs or other infusions. They help filter herbs from tinctures, including vinegar (in fire cider, for example). With approximately 20 micron-sized holes, they are not sufficient for water or air filters, but they do work as prefilters. You can also turn a mason jar into a seed sprouter with a coffee filter and a screw-top ring. Tightly woven fabric will also work in most of these uses, and be reusable.

**Clothes Pins:** Clothes dryers will be an impossible convenience in hard times due to the lack of easy access to natural gas, propane or electricity. Fortunately line-drying clothes is an easy option, provided you have enough power to run a simple washer through the spin cycle or buy a wringer. Getting the rest of the water out through line drying is as simple as stringing up a rope in the yard....until the slightest breeze blows all your carefully cleaned clothes on the ground. Stock up on wooden clothespins. They are cheap, last a long time and will be very good barter someday.

**String:** Another item with a multitude of uses that is not as common is string or twine. This is because we often reach for tape when people used to reach for string. Someday, tape will become a scarce luxury, however, and then we again appreciate the reusable aspects of string for tying up packages, closing up boxes, tying up bunches of herbs and vegetables from the garden, hanging salted meats and many other uses. I recommend a variety of sizes and strengths from kite string up to thick twine. The most useful is the medium-weight [baker's twine](#). [END]
